One Rotary President fined an electric shop owner \$10, causing him to resign!

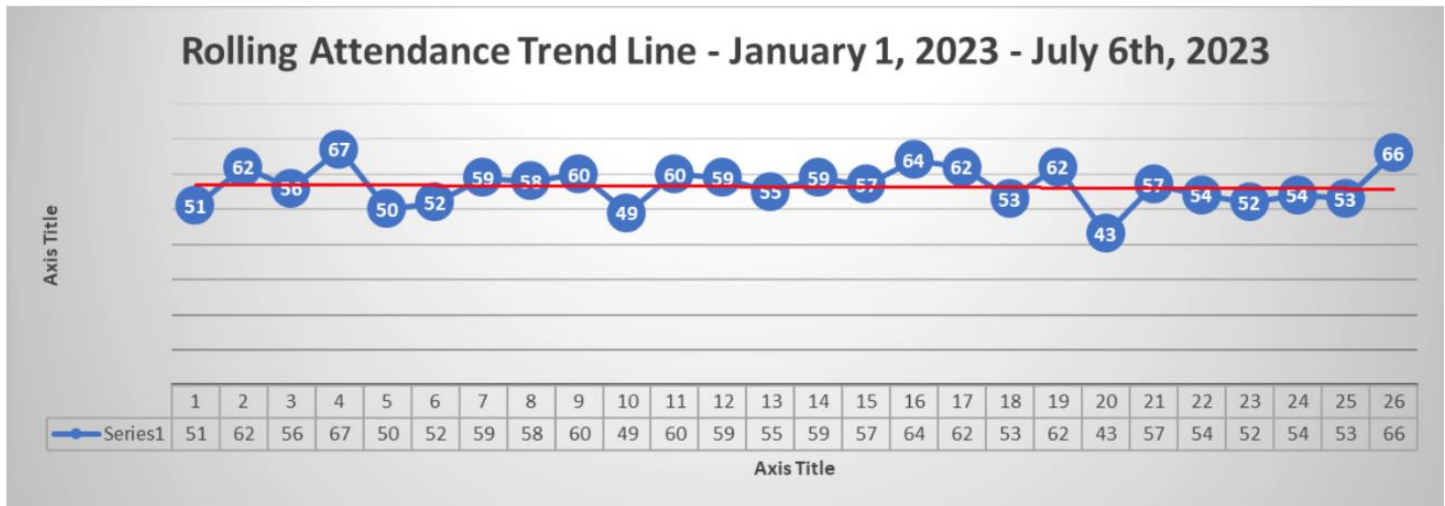
