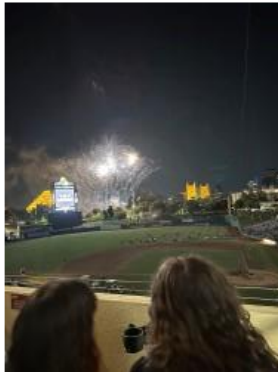

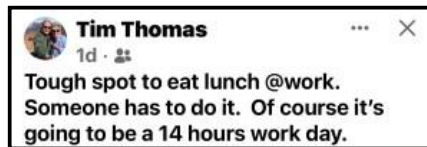
Brian Scarr and **Brad Rullman** went to a Sacramento River Cats Baseball Game.

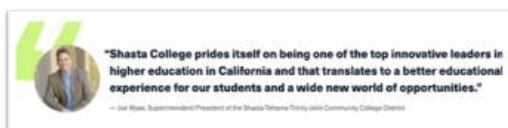

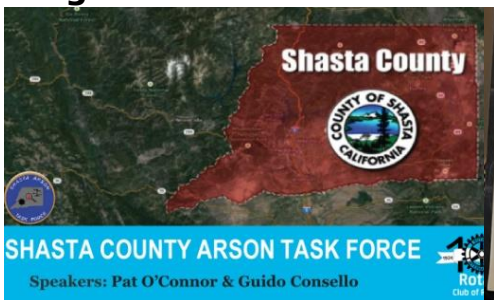

Program:



Our own, Chief **Jerrold Vandlandingham**, introduced our speakers.

They were **Pat O'Connor**, Fire Marshall, and **Guido Consello**, Fire Prevention Officer, from the Redding Fire Department. Seven (7) people now focus on County Risk Reduction (Prevention). The Shasta County Arson Tax Force is a multi-agency effort to reduce/prevent fire starting youths from reoffending. The number of youth reoffenders was over 70% prior to this introduction of this program. Over 50% of all arson events were initiated by people under eighteen (18) years old.

Now, in after about 7 years in operation, through engagement with these young people, the number of reoffending "firesetters," from this participating group, is less than one-fourth of what it was prior to the program's inception!

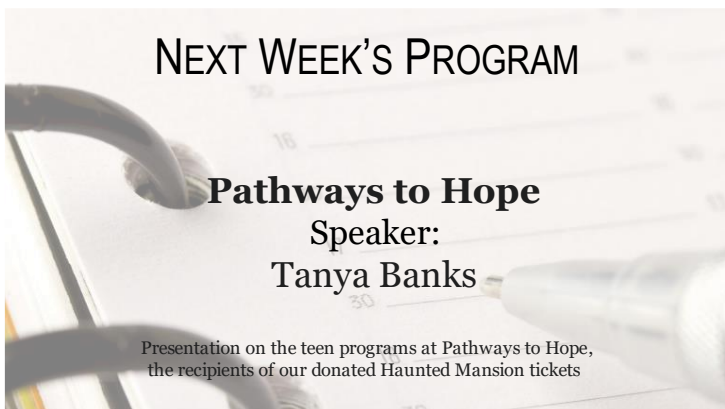

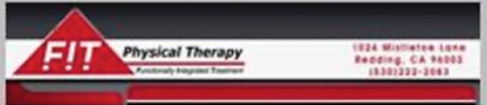
