



Today's Program - Fortera Cement

Todd Jones introduced our speakers for today representing Fortera: **Craig Hargis**, VP of Products, and **Philip Tuet**, VP of Engineering. Fortera is a San Jose based company that has been developing a new process for producing a reduced CO2 emissions cement product. Surprisingly, 8% of all global greenhouse gases are caused by cement manufacturing. Their process is a huge step in the direction of reducing our carbon footprint.

Craig gave some background on the company and explained their partnership with Redding's CalPortland Cement Plant. Construction on their Redding ReCarb Plant is expected to be

completed later this year. This commercial-scale plant will be the first of it's kind anywhere and it hopefully serve as model for other partnerships around the globe. A huge benefit for our region is the addition of construction, manufacturing, and infrastructure jobs.

The process they've pioneered is call ReCarb and their finished product is called ReAct. They have over 10 years of real-world testing of their product proving its strength and compatibility with additives, fillers, and fibers.

Their process is based on the observation of how coral and seashells use CO2 as cement ingredient to form hard calcium-based structures in the ocean. Fortera's process re-introduces CO2 back into the product as it's being processed, rather than releasing it to the atmosphere.




