

SENTINELS OF FREEDOM LUNCHEON

Redding Chamber executive Todd Jones was keynote speaker at Thursday's 11th Annual Rotary Sentinel Send-Off Luncheon at which 38 area high school seniors who have chosen to serve in the United States Armed Forces, a military/service academy, National Guard, Reserve or ROTC, were recognized in a room filled with high energy and patriotism and presented with a special certificate by President Jennifer Finnegan for volunteering to serve in the United States military following graduation.

The meeting kicked off with Joe Girimonte presenting the flag salute, followed by Rick Fauss leading everyone in singing "God Bless America" and Colin Duffy delivering the invocation. Bob and Molly Skinner of the Jefferson Pipe Band piped a special tribute to the 22 high school military volunteers.



Jones, a Marine Corps veteran, told the recruits how his service impacted his life and that 90% of

success in the military was maintaining positive mental focus. Originally from Weaverville, Jones enlisted in the Marine Corps after high school, became a Topographical Intelligence Specialist, with postings in Washington, D.C. and Okinawa Japan.

Later, Jones achieve a degree in Political Science from Humboldt State University and an MBA from

Western Governors University. His professional career includes time in the Redding Field Office Staff of former U. S. Congressman Wally Herger, working with various Bay Area organizations through a fellowship with the Center for Civic Leadership & Public Affairs, and time as head of the Shasta Economic Development Council, before assuming his present role as CEO and President of the Redding Chamber of Commerce.

The recruits were identified in a four-month process, with members of the Veterans Committee making contact with military recruiters and many high school principals and staffs. Each recruit received a personal letter of invitation and could invite two additional guests.

Greg Balkovek organized the program with the assistance of Tim Thomas, Nikola Hawes, Ian Striping, Art Smithson, Cindy Fisher, Jerry Kelly, Trudy Tavares and others.

"Each of the students has chosen a military path at this point and time in their life," Balkovek said. "Some see it as a path to higher education, others for adventure; some to find out who they are and where they want to go I life. They will travel to places they've only see in the news or read about. Some will see and do things that will truly test their mettle. Others will find a career. All will mature. The road they have chosen is not for everyone, as not everyone can, or would, travel this military road. All are volunteers."


