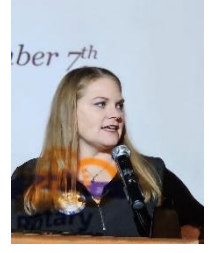

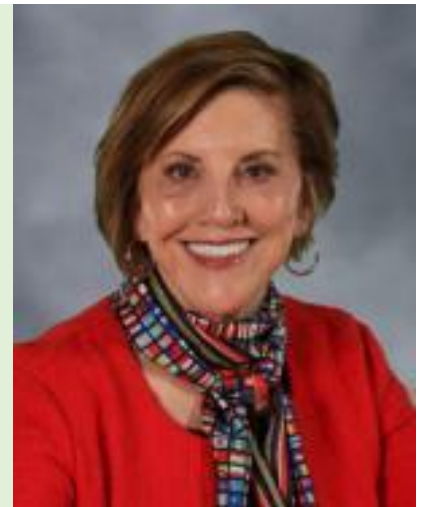

We "clawed" \$100 out of his pocket, but there was no leftover crab for the club.

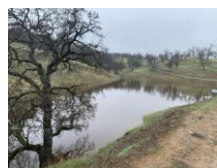
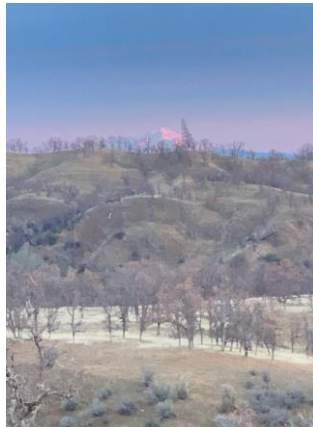
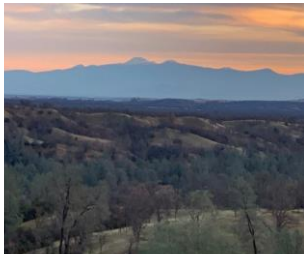

To honor this effort by **Pat**, **PP Jeff Avery**, offered \$100 to the club!

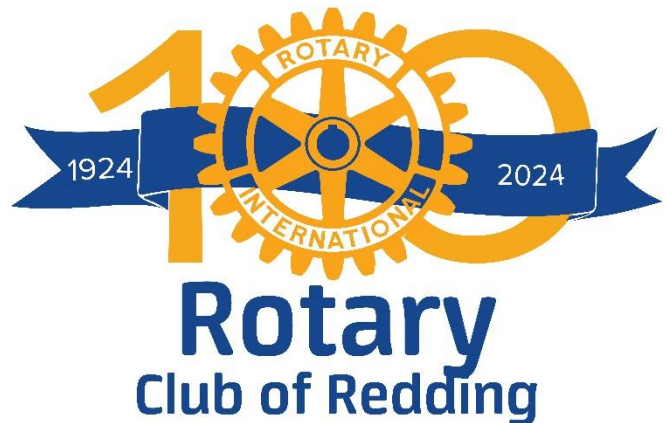

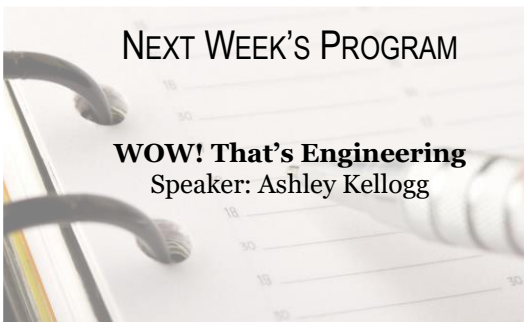
