

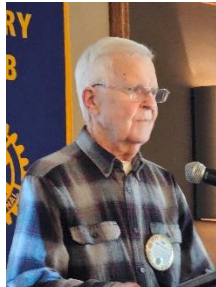


Historical Perspective on the Middle East, Israel-Palestine

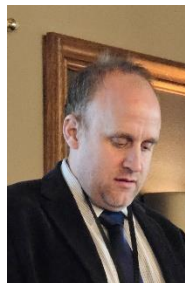
