
This was the $3^{\rm rd}$ club sponsored by the Rotary Club of Redding, and this time we were joined by a co-sponsor club Redding-East.

Ken Wood introduced our speaker, **Scott Morris**, from Upstate Hearing.




The program discussed hearing loss and the impacts of hearing deprivation on your health.

Even "mild" hearing loss can cause a tremendous amount of information loss.

So, "mild" hearing can be as lifechanging as total hearing loss.






When it is not working properly, it adds new "loads" (processing/decoding mode).

Other sensors also kick-in to collect more information when your hearing is lacking.

All this added processing can also make it more difficult to remember pieces or complete conversations, as you brain focuses on decoding rather than storing.







New studies indicate that hearing deficits, because of the additional effort required by the brain, over the long-term, can greatly impact the structure and function of the brain.

The longer the hearing deficit exists, the more impact this can have on the functionality of the brain, especially in the area of speech recognition.

In addition to the functional issues, social disengagement can also arise from the difficulty in communicating. With that, many other issues such as depreciation, etc. can materialize.

So, as you can see, hearing deprivation can greatly affect your life if you do not address it.


