




- Remove & Replace South City Park Building (\$7,000,000)

- Baseball Field Complex (\$7,000,000)
- Space Expansion for Parks and Building Maintenance at Corp Yard (\$9,000,000)
- Additional amenities such as expansions of lighting, shade structures, and improvements (\$5\$)

How Redding Compares - Revenue


Revenue from sales & property tax per




Public Safety and the General Fund


Sales and Property Tax + Public Safety Cost
