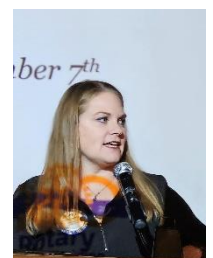

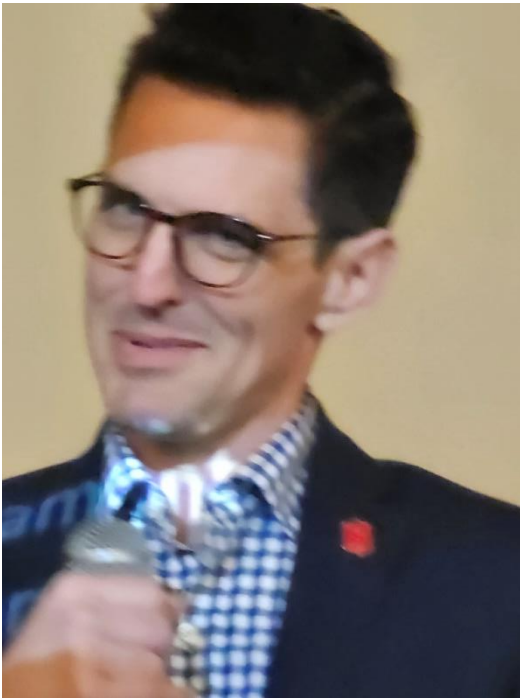

Dr. Middlebrook is a lecturer at Simpson among a number of other endeavors he participates in, many of which are involved with the controversial topic of AI in education and life.


