The beautiful Wood Duck went from being almost extinct 100 years ago to being a vibrant and plentiful member of our local environment.

PP Jeff Avery offered to contribute \$100, on behalf of **Randy Smith** and **PP Pat Corey**, for a total of \$200 to the Endowment, in recognition of these efforts and the wonderful benefits these habitats provide.
