BOARD MEETING UPDATE

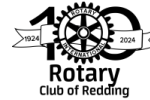
- **Committee Chairs** – Directors identified committee chairs for next year.

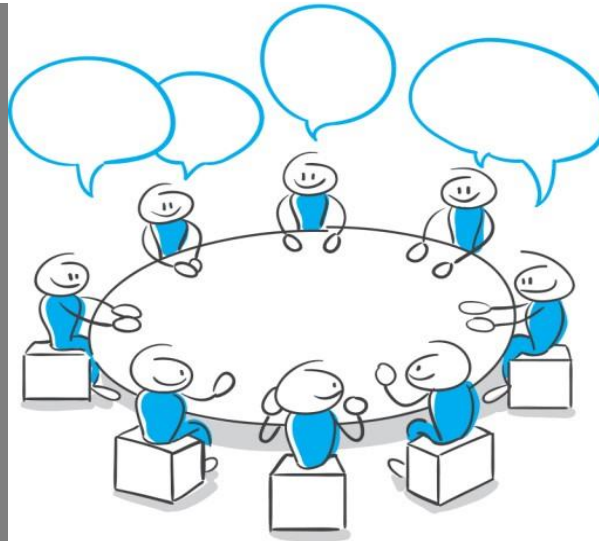
Celebrating both graduation from high school and the forth coming entry into the US Coast Guard.

Speaker: Mary Brace, Club Secretary



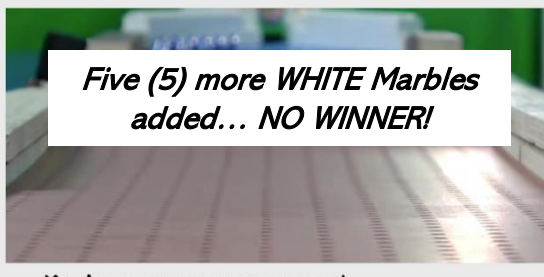

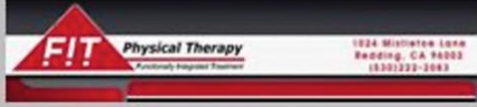
