HISTORY MINUTE

In November, 2000 our club received a \$40,000 matching grant from Rotary International. The funds were used to purchase dental equipment to fully equip three new dental operatories at the Bongolo Evangelical Hospital in Gabon, Africa. The project was enhanced by a US dentist, Dr. Jeff Amstutz, DDS, who spent four years in Gabon training the three dentists to serve their community.

Our club partnered with several other Rotary clubs to make this happen including Redding West, Redding East, Redding Sunrise, Anderson, and Rotary Club of Doyen in Libreville, Gabon.


