Today's Program - THRIVE Emerging Leaders

Our own **Trisha Funk** spoke today about Thrive Emerging Leaders Program, an initiative by the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA). The program, which has been operational nationwide since 2008, aims to support established businesses ready to scale to the next level. This year marked a milestone as it was the first time a cohort was introduced in Northern California, specifically in Redding, providing a unique opportunity for local businesses to benefit from this initiative.

Having joined the SBA in late 2023, **Trisha** previously directed a federally designated women's business center for six years. Her

experience highlighted a gap in support services for businesses beyond the startup phase but not yet at the multi-million dollar level. These businesses often lack the resources to hire full-time financial advisors or CFOs, making programs like Thrive crucial for their growth.

The Thrive Emerging Leaders Program is a six-month intensive course designed for businesses with annual revenues of at least \$250,000 and a minimum of three years in operation. Participants engage in eight online modules and eight mandatory in-person sessions, culminating in the development of a three-year strategic roadmap. This roadmap is not just a vision but a detailed plan incorporating business financials, sales strategies, and HR policies.

The program's cohort model fosters a collaborative learning environment where CEOs can share experiences and strategies. This aspect was particularly valued by participants like **Penny Grant**, owner of Players Pizza in Anderson, California, and **Lori Templeton**, owner of Grind Fire Defense. Both business owners emphasized the empowerment and insights gained from interacting with peers facing similar challenges across diverse industries.

Penny, who has been in business for eight years, highlighted the program as the best decision she made as a business owner. She appreciated the camaraderie and the opportunity to learn from other business leaders, which helped her tackle challenges and explore new marketing strategies. **Lori**, whose company specializes in defensible space and fuel mitigation, found the program invaluable for systematizing her business operations and developing a strategic plan.

The Thrive Program's impact extends beyond individual businesses. Nationally, it has supported over 8,000 small business owners, created more than 11,000 jobs, and generated nearly \$1 billion in new financing. Participants are required to report their results for three years post-program, ensuring ongoing accountability and demonstrating the program's effectiveness.


