Recognitions

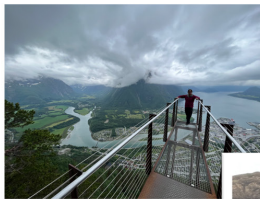

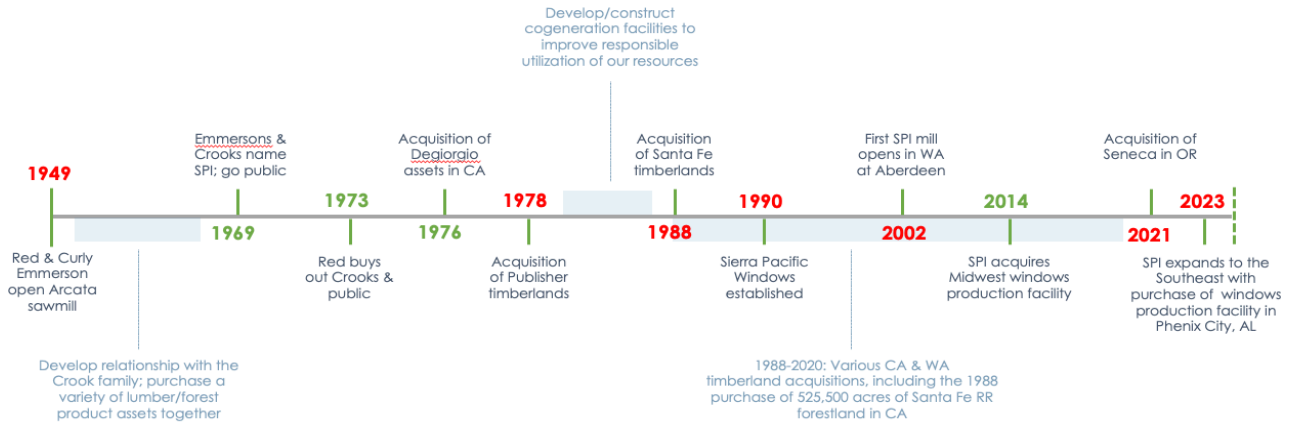

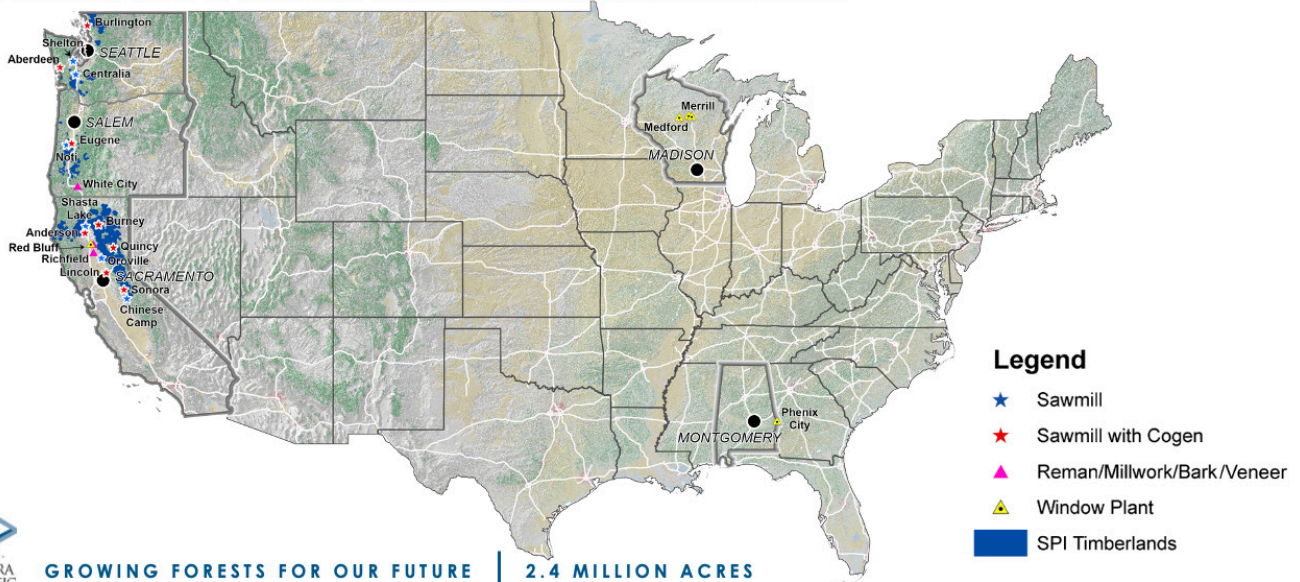
