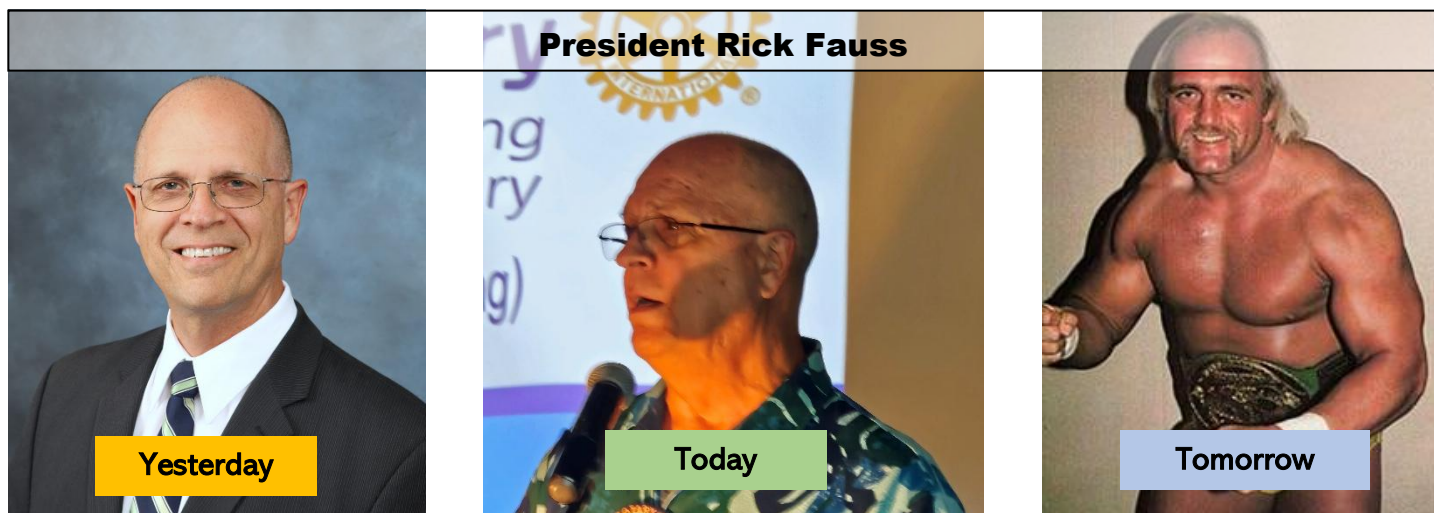




City of Redding Update

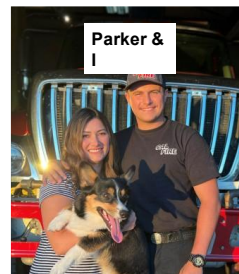

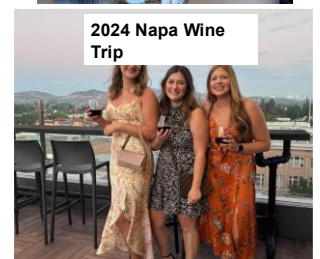

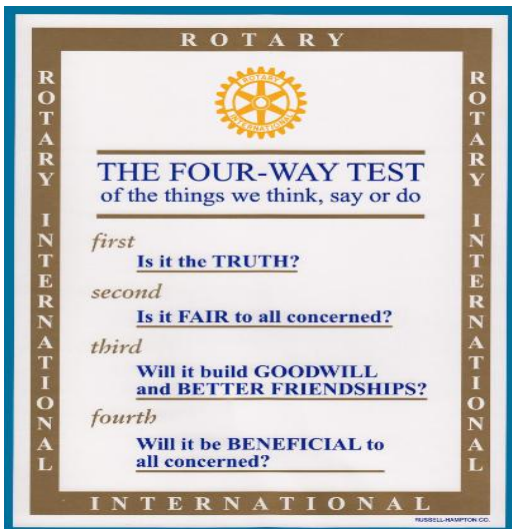
Although he is known as a kinder, gentler type of guy, in this case the rattler saw his rath! He offered \$25/ft., for a total of \$100 to the club!
