Jack Kimple announced that the Christmas Bell Ringer Committee is looking for a new leader. If you're willing, please contact **Jack**.


President Rick thanked all those who participated in the recent Fireside Chat. Here are some photos! Extra kudos to **Jason Salter** for hosting.

Today's Program: Building Bridges - United Way



Jerrod Vanlandingham presented a former member of our Club, Kristen Gray, who introduced our speakers, another former Club member, Larry Olmsted, and United Way of Northern California, Kalie Brisbon.

Larry and Kalie spoke about a new initiative launched by the United Way titled "Building Bridges". At the heart of the initiative is the goal to "lower the temperature" of civic discourse that has grown divisive in current times. The Building Bridges program is designed to refocus the conversation on issues that resonate with Shasta County residents, including public health,

addressing homelessness, and combating the opioid crisis. Through listening sessions, learning lounges, and the appointment of Building Bridges Ambassadors, United Way is mobilizing grassroots conversations to drive solutions on key issues.

Larry and Kalie encouraged everyone to join these sessions, which involve workshops focusing on emotional regulation, overcoming exclusion, and encouraging respectful debate.


The initiative also leverages partnerships with notable organizations such as the California Endowment, Powell Foundation, Ford Family Foundation, and PG&E Foundation, as well as collaboration with the Harwood Institute for Civic Innovation. These partnerships are set to enrich the community's capacity to find common ground and sustain productive dialogue. One upcoming event, scheduled for June 3, aims to gather 25 to 30 local leaders to learn strategies for uniting diverse groups, highlighting the commitment of both local and regional institutions.

The goal of Building Bridges is simple: to make civil, respectful, and inclusive conversations the standard in our communities. We aim to inspire curiosity, find common ground, and promote thoughtful, respectful discussions on the issues that matter most.


