### **Expanding Literacy in Redding**


## **Board Updates**

# Program: B29 Crash Investigation

-Guest speaker Heather Buchanan was introduced by **Jason Montague** as the author of five books, including "When the Letter Stops."

- Her presentation focused on the story of her grandfather, the navigator of a B-29 bomber

with the Hewitt crew.



- The plane was shot down over Kyushu, Japan, on July 26th, 1945.
- Nine surviving crew members were taken to the Fukuoka
   1 POW camp.
- On August 15, 1945, three hours after the emperor's surrender speech, the camp commandant had the airmen executed.
- Heather began writing the story in January 2021, 76 years after the events.
- Key materials included the contents of her grandfather's

footlocker, which had never been opened. contained uniforms, a bomber jacket, and over letters.

- Additional research involved her grandfather's journals, her grandmother's scrapbook, books like \*Flyboys\* and \*Unbroken\*, and B-29 Facebook
- She also interviewed Rufus Choate, a former who was held in the adjacent Fukuoka II camp.
- Heather was contacted by Kiriyuki Fukoa, a
   Japanese man who researches B-29 crash sites.

- Mr. Fukoa located the crash site, excavated B-29 parts, and sent them to Heather.
- He found an eyewitness, Yoshima Egashira, who was 13 at the time and had kept a drawing of the crash.
- He uncovered descriptions of how each crew member was captured and stories from two of the executioners.
- He also found a story from villagers who cared for an airman they found, believed to be Heather's grandfather, before turning him in to the police.
- This airman gave the family a pendant with a picture of a woman and a little girl.
- Mr. Fukoa holds an annual memorial ceremony for the Hewitt crew on July 27th.
- Heather's book was officially released during the ceremony in Japan in 2021.



- A news segment about the ceremony prompted another witness, Seiko Baba, to share his family's story of finding the airman with the pendant.
- Heather and her daughter plan to travel to Japan in 2026 to attend the ceremony and meet Mr. Fukoa.


